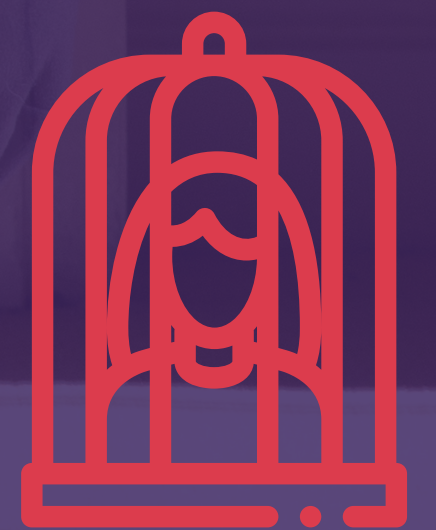


Domestic abuse isn't confined to the home

UP TO **75%** OF VICTIMS
ARE TARGETED AT WORK

through repeated calls and visits to their workplace

66% OF ABUSED WOMEN MISS AT LEAST
THREE DAYS OF WORK PER MONTH
